



# APPROVED FRAMEWORK FOR THE CHAPTER OF CONSERVATION ARCHITECTS

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## MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

The membership criteria for the Chapter of Conservation Architects shall be founded on:

- Knowledge of heritage buildings, their architectural forms and styles;
- Knowledge of conservation philosophies, principles and their evolution;
- Knowledge of restoration techniques and methodologies within the local industry presently;
- Proven practical experience on multiple architectural conservation projects;
- Proficiency and understanding of international charters, guidelines, conventions and other relevant documents;
- Commitment to abide by the Code of Practice, to apply and abide by recognised standards and guidelines, and to follow the continuous professional development (CPD) in the field of architectural conservation; and
- Have a warrant to practice as a 'perit' in Malta, be recognised as a member of the Kamra tal-Periti and be in possession of a renewed membership with the Chapter as per the Terms and Regulations that the Kamra may issue from time to time

A three-tier affiliation system for membership with the Chapter is to be adopted: Associate, Member, & Fellow; with Fellow being the highest tier and given to a full member of the Chapter based on merit and demonstration of extensive knowledge and experience in building conservation. Associate tier affiliation shall not be considered as full membership.
